

## Notes for Contributors

The *Taiwanese Journal of Sociology* (TJS) (ISSN 1011-2219) is published semi-annually in June and December by the Taiwanese Sociological Association. *TJS* publishes original works in sociology and related areas and reviews on books or other forms of publications published during the most recent years in Taiwan or elsewhere. Research articles, research issues, research notes, and reviews are all welcome.

### I . Types of Paper

*TJS* classifies papers into four types and sets the word limits for different types of papers.

1. **Research Articles:** Original research works of interest to the discipline in general (10,000 word limit).
2. **Research Notes:** Preliminary research results with potential to build specific theoretical issues and newly developed concepts (5,000 word limit).
3. **Research Issues, Review Articles, and Critical Reviews:** A comprehensive and systematic discussion on issues and reviews on newly developed special topics (5,000 word limit).
4. **Reviews:** Reviews on academic books are published home and abroad in three years, and films and movies are concerned with sociological topics (1,000 word limit).

### II . Manuscript Format

1. Manuscripts should be submitted in MS Word or other compatible software with numbered pages, and a cover sheet.
2. Cover sheet should include the topic of the paper, the type of paper, the number of words, the name of the author, and his/her affiliated institution and title, address and telephone number, e-mail address and acknowledgements.
3. Manuscripts must include the following: cover sheet, abstract in English (150 word limit), key words in English (5 term limit), abstract in Chinese (500 word limit), key words in Chinese (5 term limit), full text, appendices and references.

III. All manuscripts are evaluated by anonymous reviewers. The manuscript should be prepared in accordance with the rules of good scientific practice and those who violate the ethical standards will be banned from submitting for two years.

IV. If published, each contributor will receive the PDF digital file of the article as well as five copies of the journal. And in accordance with the request, the contributor will receive additional 50 off-prints of the article.
